CATEGORIES

Salming Norwegian Junior Open 2017 is open to players, girls and boys under the age of 19, 17, 15 and 13 on the final day of the event. Due to national regulations the U13 class is only open to boys and girls from the Nordic and Baltic countries (including Russia). Players can participate from the year they turn 11, and are eligible provided the player isn't banned under the [ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines](#) section C.4.e, section E.4.a or section E.4.b. There will be a maximum draw of 32 players per category.

A player can enter only one category.

SPIN

All players must have registered and paid for SPIN to participate – see www.worldsquash.org/spin to register.

ENTRIES

Only entries made through and/or endorsed by the relevant national federation will be accepted.

TRANSPORT (package 3)

Transportation will be provided on arrival / departure to / from/ Vøyenbrua bus stop or the hotel.

There are two alternative bus routes, depending on traveling to/from the venue or to/from the hotel. See details below.
Participants will only be picked up if they notify the tournament organizers of their arrival times before Monday, 20th February.

There will be a car transfer service between hotel and venue for all participants having purchased a tournament package including hotel.

DRAWS AND SEEDINGS

The seeding and schedules will be published at least 5 days before the start of the event.

The seeding and draw will be carried out using the ESF Junior Rankings valid at the tournament closing date, in accordance with the [ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines](#) section D.

MATCHES

All matches will be played as best of five games with PAR 11 scoring to 2 clear points.

All players will be guaranteed a minimum of three scheduled matches.

All positions in the categories will be played out.

ESF approved balls (Dunlop) will be used in all matches.

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

Wearing approved eye protection on court is mandatory at all times. Players will not be allowed to compete without approved eye protection.

PRIZES

There will be trophies and prize money awarded in the U19 boys and girls categories. In all other categories, there will be trophies and gift prizes.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organizers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance.

PUBLISHING STATEMENT

The tournament organizers will publish draws, results, stories and photos of players at venue and hotel. As this is part of the tournament rules, the organizer will deem that players and their parents have accepted these regulations by entering the tournament.

ESF PENALTIES from ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines section E.

- §E.4.a If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament, a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to ESF no later than two days after the final day of the tournament (email: esf@europeansquash.com). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless ESF receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the tournament finishing.
If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
- §E.4.b If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.
If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
- §E.4.c If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to ESF within two days of the tournament finishing. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.
If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

Transportation from/to the airport

If you are going directly to the venue (Myrens Sportssenter) take the [Flybussekspressen](#), F1 Majorstua (Sørkedalsvein). Going from the airport (approx. 55 min.), your stop is Vøyenbrua.
